

2024 EMERGING LEADER AWARD

The Texas Bankers Foundation is excited to accept nominations for the 6th Annual Emerging Leader Award. This provides TBA member CEOs and presidents the opportunity to recognize an individual in their institution who they believe has the potential to be a future leader not only in their bank but for our industry.

Emerging Leader Award nominees should be individuals who the bank's CEO believes will lead their banks into the future, who is making a positive professional and community impact and who represents the best values of Texas community banking.

Eligibility:

- Nominee must have at least five (5) years, but no more than 20 years in banking (by December 31, 2023).
- Nominee must be an employee of a TBA-member banking institution.
- Nomination must be made by the bank president, CEO or board chairman.
- Only one nomination per bank charter.

Individuals at an EVP, C-Suite, or Bank/Regional/Market President level are not eligible for the Emerging Leader Award.

Emerging Leader Award recipients will receive:

- The Emerging Leader Award during the 50-Year Banker and Emerging Leader Awards luncheon at the TBA's 139th Annual Convention held at the Loews Arlington Hotel in May 2024.
- A complimentary registration to a TBA conference, school or annual convention (excludes MDP and the Banker Forums).
- Recipients will be recognized in TBA's social media posts, press release and in the Texas Banking magazine.
- Emerging Leader Award recipients will be invited to serve a one-year term on TBA's Bank Leadership Council (BLC).

Nomination should include:

- The completed nomination form signed by the bank president, CEO or board chairman.
- Statement about candidate from bank president, CEO or board chairman.
- Statement from the nominee on career goals, ambitions and why he/she chose banking as a career.
- Nominee's resume.
- Headshot of nominee and at least 8-10 photos of the nominee participating in bank events and community activities. One or two photos of nominee with family are also welcome.

Nominations must be submitted by Thursday, February 29, 2024.
